

Museum etiquette for a school class visit

We warmly welcome you to our three museums: Barfüsserkirche, Haus zum Kirschgarten and the Music Museum.

To ensure that your visit as a school class is a pleasant and positive experience, we ask you to respect the house rules and the following regulations:

1. the teacher accompanies the class and is responsible for them during the entire visit.
2. the teacher must always ensure that the children and young people behave appropriately and considerately. Jumping around, shouting or shouting is not permitted.
3. jackets, bags, rucksacks, drinks bottles etc. may be deposited in special group lockers in the Barfüsserkirche. Please use the general cloakroom and lockers in the Music Museum and Haus zum Kirschgarten.
4. exhibits that are explicitly on display for touching in the museum are specially labelled. Screens and listening station devices must be operated with care.
5. All other exhibits may not be touched.
6. sitting on the floor is permitted if other museum visitors are not disturbed.
7. the rules of behaviour in the museum should be discussed with the group/class before the visit. Pupils show understanding when they realise that museum items are unique, irreplaceable objects of high cultural value.
8. the house rules for museum visitors remain reserved.
9. the instructions of the staff must be followed in order to ensure everyone's safety and a pleasant stay.
