Richard Sutcliffe studied classical violin and music education at the Crane School of Music in Potsdam, New York before specializing in early music performance at the Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel. He continued his studies at the Orpheus Institute, Ghent and finally earned a PhD in musicology at the University of Huddersfield, UK. He has worked as research coordinator for the library of the Brussels Conservatoire as well as head librarian for the Ghent Conservatoire. Since December 2023 he is a researcher at the Brussels Musical Instruments Museum and the UCLouvain where he is organizing and researching the archives of the museum in order to write a history of that institution from 1876 to 1992.
