## Code of Conduct for Private Photo Shoots

- All participants must buy an individual admission ticket.
   Groups may not exceed a maximum of 12 people.
- The time spent inside the museum may not exceed
   1 ½ hours.
- Time slots: 11 a.m. –12.30 p.m., 1.00–2.30 p.m., 3–4.30 p.m.
- The attendants' instructions must be followed at all times.

  Attendants can declare certain rooms off limits.
- Objects and antique furniture may not be touched or moved.
- Special care must be taken with large groups. The furniture and paintings must not be adversely affected in any way.
- Curtains may not be drawn nor the furniture moved.
   This rule also applies to the photographers themselves.
- Please be considerate of other visitors.
- Smoking, eating and drinking inside the museum is strictly prohibited.
- The scattering of rice, petals, glitter or any other materials inside the building is strictly prohibited.
   Soap bubbles and balloons are likewise strictly prohibited.
- Only photography WITHOUT flash is permitted.
- Please forward this document to your photographer.
   A signed copy of these rules must be handed in at the ticket desk on the day of the shoot.
